What is Botox?

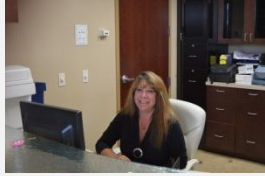

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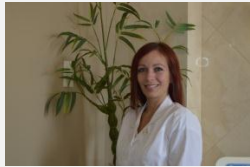

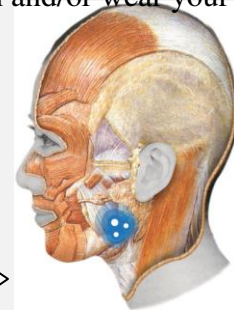

Do you frequently wake up with a tired jaw or have chronic tension headaches? Bruxism is a condition in which you grind or clench your teeth. If you have bruxism, you may unconsciously clench your teeth together during the day or grind them at night. Ideally at rest, our teeth are NOT supposed to touch each other.

Bruxism is very common, especially in women, and when the condition is mild, may not require treatment. However, if bruxism is severe enough, it can lead to temporomandibular joint disorders (TMJD, TMJ or TMD), headaches, and damage the restorations in your mouth and/or wear your natural teeth.

In order to prevent your teeth from wearing, dentists first prescribe professional grade mouth guards to be worn at night. However, upon follow up, patients have said that although they feel their teeth are protected during their sleep, they feel that they are clenching even harder, biting into their night guard all night long.
